Summary of Program Activity

- □ Seven projects were approved for approximately \$3.8 million.
- □ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$14.1 million available in state fiscal year 2024 and \$18.0 million available in state fiscal year 2025 for cost share projects.
- □ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$2.8 million available in state fiscal year 2022, \$3.6 million available in state fiscal year 2023, \$9.0 million available in state fiscal year 2024 and \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2024 for cost share projects that encourage economic development.

MoDOT's Cost Share Program Partnerships Approved

City of Bowling Green - \$929,900 to construct a break-in-access and turn lanes on Route 54 at the industrial park.

City of Ashland - \$392,710 to extend Perry Avenue and remove an existing entrance on Route 63.

City of Moberly - \$1,056,161 to widen and add a center turn lane on Business Route 63.

City of Fulton - \$300,233 to add a two-way left turn lane on Business Route 54.

Ralls County R-II School District - \$145,354 to construct a left turn lane on Route 19 at Mark Twain Junior and Senior High Schools.

City of O'Fallon - \$645,000 to construct dual left turn lanes on eastbound and westbound Route N at Route K.

City of Cape Girardeau - \$296,000 to construct a right-in/right-out intersection on eastbound and westbound Route 74 at Minnesota Avenue.
