Sealed bids for the Chesterfield Riparian Trail – Phase 2 TAP 5410(630) will be received by the City of Chesterfield Department of Public Works, 690 Chesterfield Parkway West; Chesterfield, MO 63017 until 10:00 A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>July 27</u>, <u>2021</u> at the office of the Local Public Agency (LPA), and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in paper form.

The proposed work includes the construction of a 10' wide ADA compliant asphalt trail with associated earthwork, tree removal, stormwater, retaining walls, fences, parking lot, pedestrian bridges, and all other work as described in the plans and specifications.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Chesterfield hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on this public works project must provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Chesterfield reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 10%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
