

**CITY OF TOWN AND COUNTRY – TOPPING ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PHASE I

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the Topping Road Improvements Phase I STP-5532(611) will be received by the City Clerk for City of Town and Country, 1011 Municipal Center Drive, Town and Country, Missouri, 63131, until **10:00 AM CDT, August 16th, 2021** in the Community Room at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids shall be submitted in writing on the provided itemized bid forms.

The Scope of Work includes sidewalk installation, roadway resurfacing, signal, storm sewer, and landscaping improvements.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Town and Country hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Town and Country shall award any contract based on the proposal that, in its sole discretion, best meets the interests and requirements of the City. The City of Town and Country reserves the right in its sole discretion to reject any and all proposals, to waive technicalities or deficiencies in any or all the proposals, to negotiate with any or all bidders or others for other or more favorable terms or prices, and/or to award the contract to other than the bidder submitting the lowest cost proposal, with or without negotiation.

The DBE Goal for this project is 16%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
