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MoDOT Construction Projects

1. Go to www.modot.org
2. Click on “Doing Business with MoDOT”



3. Scroll down and click on “Online Plans Room”



4. On this page you can view the most recently advertised MoDOT letting. You can view proposals for that month’s letting by clicking on this icon for a particular project:
5. In the proposal, you can view the project line items and see if there are any opportunities for your company to subcontract or bid as a prime.
 - a. Please remember that if you bid as a prime, you firm must be able to do a minimum of 40% of the work.



6. The projects are organized by call number. Each call number corresponds to a district:
 - A Call: Northwest
 - B Call: Northeast
 - C Call: Kansas City
 - D Call: Central
 - F Call: St. Louis
 - G Call: Southwest
 - H Call: Southeast

7. At the top, you can click on the “Plan Holder List (MoDOT Planroom) to view the plan holders by call:

8. If you click on the call that you want to bid on, it will give you the list of firms who have requested the project plans and are likely to bid on the project. It denotes which firms are prime contractors. If you want to bid as a subcontractor, you can contact any or all of these companies and let them know that you are interested in the project along with what your firm's capabilities are. You may also submit quotes to these companies as well.

You will need to find the county the project is located at and the craft to determine which wage applies to any one project. Be sure to look at both Federal and State Wage Rates as some MoDOT projects include both federal and state funding and employees will need to be paid the higher of the two.



3. Once there, you can find information on projects in procurement. Click on each project to find more information about the project, including timelines and public notices such as for RFQ's & SOQ's.

MissouriBUYS (Procurement)

1. MissouriBUYS is the states eProcurement system. On this website, vendors can view procurement opportunities for goods and services that they may be able to provide to a state agency, including MoDOT. The website is: <https://missouribuys.mo.gov/>
2. Prior to bidding, vendors must register their company in order to bid on procurement opportunities.
3. Be sure to have the following information ready when registering:
 - Organization's Taxpayer ID Number (TIN)
 - Business Type (Corporation, LLC, Sole Proprietorship, etc.)
 - Email Address
 - ACH-EFT Payment Information
 - Internal Revenue Service W-9 Form, Request for Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) and Certification
4. Once registered, firms will receive emails regarding bidding opportunities based on the work types they select as they become available.
