Sealed bids will be received by the City of Warsaw, Missouri at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 201 West Main, P.O. Box 68, Warsaw, Missouri 65355 until 2:00 P.M. on the 5th of November, 2021 on a capital improvement project described in general as "Steamboat Landing, FEMA Project 120333 DR4551 Boardwalk on Lake" in the City of Warsaw, Missouri. Bids will NOT be accepted after this date and time under any circumstances. Due to Co-Vid 19 Protocols, there will be no in-person public opening of Bids. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud via Zoom Meeting with a date and time to be established in a forthcoming Addendum.

Prevailing Wage rates apply to this project. State Wage Rates may be downloaded from the Internet via Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Labor Laws/ Wages, Hours and Dismissal Rights/ General Wage Order 28).

The proposed work includes: Boardwalk Removal and Protection, Handrail Removal and Reinstall - 936 Lineal Feet, Installation of new Boardwalk – 12,375 Square Feet, Shoreline Armor Restoration – 59 Cubic Yards, Sidewalk Transition – 135 Square Feet, Light Post Modification – 8 Each, Gravel Border – 1165 Linear Feet and Pervious Paver – 185 Square feet.

The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in these appendices. When Federal wage rates are applicable and included, this contract is subject to the "Work Hours Act of 1962", (P.L. 87-581: 76 Stat. 357) and implementing regulations.

The City hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Bid Security will be required in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bidder qualifications may be required in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "Bid for Steamboat Landing, Federal Project 120333 DR4551 Boardwalk on Lake in the City of Warsaw, Missouri." Bids received after the designated closing time will be returned unopened.

CONTRACTOR SHOULD READ AND BE FULLY FAMILIAR WITH ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS BEFORE SUBMITTING A BID. IN SUBMITTING A BID, THE BIDDER WARRANTS THAT IT HAS READ THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND IS FULLY FAMILIAR THEREWITH AND THAT IT HAS VISITED THE SITE OF THE WORK TO FULLY INFORM ITSELF AS TO ALL EXISTING CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS AND SHALL INCLUDE IN ITS BID A SUM TO COVER THE COST OF ALL ITEMS OF THE WORK.

The prospective participants must certify by submittal of EPA Form 5700-49, Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension and Other Responsibility Matters, that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, it and its principles are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any federal department or agency.

Should a bidder find "defects"; it shall bring such "defects" to the attention of City. Changes necessitated thereby shall be in the form of addenda issued by the Consulting Engineer.

All bidders shall verify that they have considered all written addenda. Neither the City nor the Consulting Engineer shall be responsible for oral instructions. Any written addenda issued during the time of bidding shall be covered and included in the bid. There will be no clarifications or exceptions allowed on the Bid. Bids are for a total bid package, total contract price.

The City of Warsaw, Missouri, reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and to waive any technicalities or irregularities therein. Bids may be modified or withdrawn by written request of the bidder received in the office of the City Clerk, prior to the time and date for bid opening; provided, however, that no bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) days from the date set for the opening thereof. ALL BIDDERS AGREE THAT REJECTION SHALL CREATE NO LIABILITY ON THE PART OF THE CITY BECAUSE OF SUCH REJECTION, AND THE FILING OF ANY BID IN RESPONSE TO THIS INVITATION SHALL CONSTITUTE AN AGREEMENT OF THE BIDDER TO THESE CONDITIONS.
