

BUSINESS LOOP 49 (RANGE LINE ROAD) BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

PROJECT FACTS

- Replace Business Loop 49 (Range Line Road) bridge over Kansas City Southern Railroad
- New bridge two feet higher, 15 feet wider, 27 feet shorter than current bridge including sidewalks on both sides of bridge



- Bridge built in 1976
- Bridge carries 24,580 vehicles a day
- This bridge is included in Gov. Mike Parson's \$351 million Focus on Bridges program, which will repair or replace 250 bridges



- Project completed by Dec.1, 2022
- Estimated Total Cost: \$6.2 million
- Financial incentive for early completion

- Business Loop 49 (Range Line Road) bridge CLOSED for maximum of 87 calendar days
- Detour: Jasper Co. Rt. FF (32nd St.), Missouri Rt. 249, Missouri Rt. 66 (7th St.)

Signed detour using 32nd Street (Jasper County Route FF), 7th Street (Missouri Route 66) and I-44.

No left turns from eastbound 32nd Street (Route FF) on to Davis Boulevard east of Range Line Road (Loop 49).
