- 1

I-44 bridge replacement -- Replaces the Broadway bridge over I-44 and the ramp from the I-70 express lanes onto the Broadway bridge. Work may begin as early as February 2022, weather permitting. Work should be complete by mid-2023.
- 2

I-55 bridge improvements – This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 into the city. In 2022, work includes the bridges between I-44 and Holly Hills. Drivers can expect narrowed and shifted lanes within that section. This year, crews rehabilitate the northbound and southbound bridges over South Broadway (3200 and 4500 South Broadway), as well as bridges at Virginia, Bates, Gasconade, Potomac, and replace the bridge deck over South 2nd Street. This portion of the project also removes a pedestrian bridge over I-55 north of Reavis Barracks Road. Project continues through summer 2024.

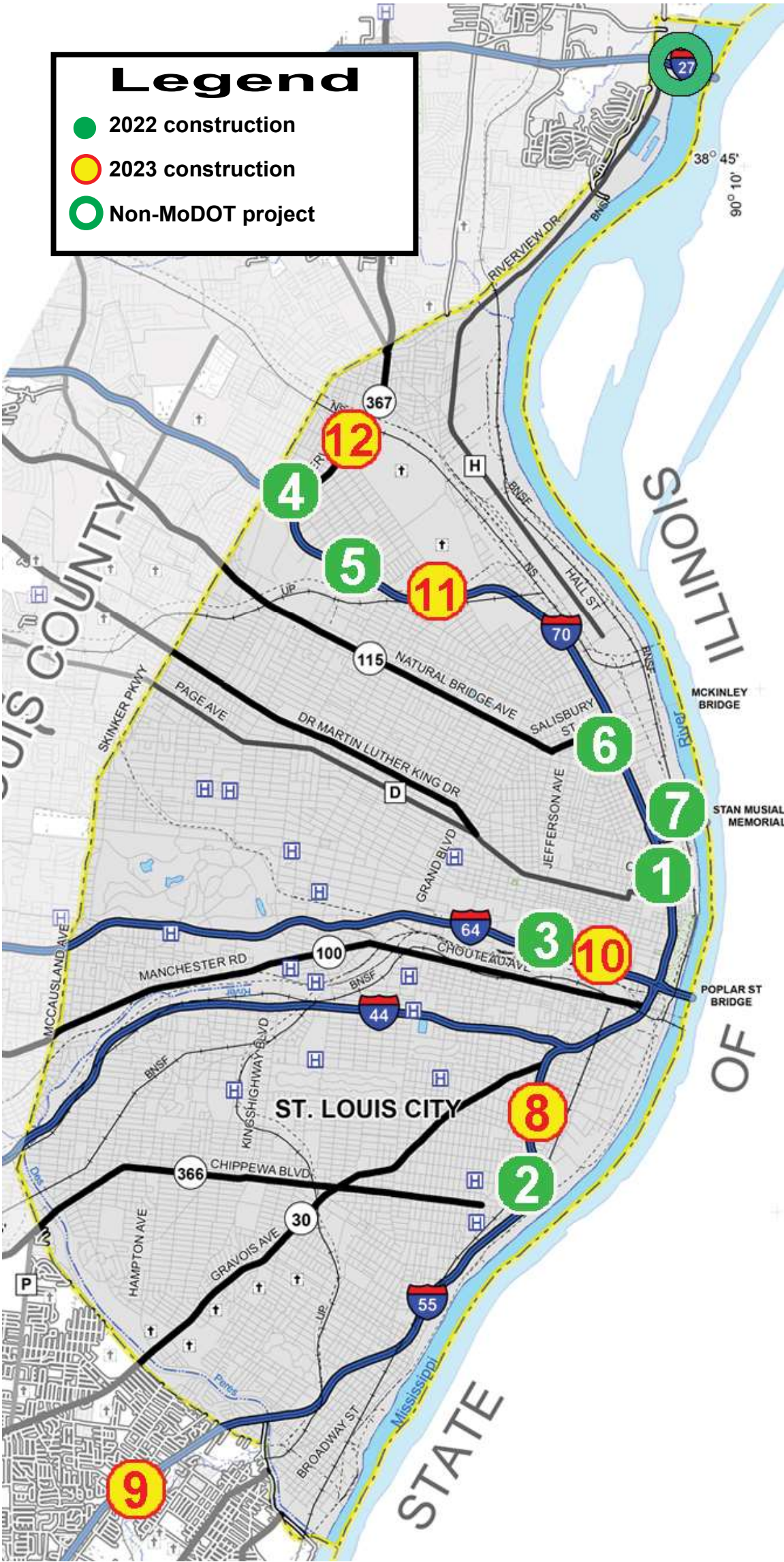
I-64 interchange improvements – This project makes improvements to the I-64 interchange with Jefferson and 22nd Street. Work is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2022.
- 4

I-70 sign upgrades – Structural signs along I-70 within the city limits will be inspected and upgraded to current safety and reflectivity standards. Work will start in mid-2022 and continue through 2023
- 5

I-70 bridge improvements – This project updates the driving surfaces on 14 bridges on between North Hanley and Madison Streets. Work includes an overlay on the Adelaide bridge.

I-70 pavement improvements – This project resurfaces I-70 between Branch and Biddle Street. Includes guardrail updates and sidewalk work on various sections of the outer roads between Salisbury and Biddle to ensure the sidewalks meet Americans with Disability Act requirements.
- 7

I-70 bridge washing – This project washes the I-70 Stan Musial Veterans Memorial Bridge at the Mississippi River.
- I-270 bridge construction** -- Illinois Department of Transportation project. Constructs a new I-270 bridge across the Mississippi River north of city of St. Louis. Construction on the new bridge begins in mid-2022, although initial traffic impacts should be minimal.



The following 2022 projects will continue construction in 2023:

I-55 pavement improvements – The northbound and southbound lanes of I-55 between I-44 in the city of St. Louis and the Holly Hills overpass will be resurfaced. The resurfacing work includes upgraded guardrail and upgrading sidewalk/ramps to meet current standards.
- 9

I-55 bridge improvements – This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 into the city. In 2023, work includes the bridges between Holly Hills and Lindbergh.

I-64 signal replacements – This project updates the signal at the eastbound exit ramp to 14th Street
- 11

I-70 signal replacements – This project updates the signal at the eastbound exit ramp to West Florissant Ave.
- 12

Route 367 pavement improvements – This project updates the driving surface on the route from the Halls Ferry Circle to I-70.

Drivers can expect narrowed and shifted lanes within that section. Cyclists can also expect a full closure of the Carondelet Connector near River Des Peres and short duration closures of the River Des Peres and Grants Trail greenways. This year, crews will rehabilitate the bridges at Koeln, Loughborough and Bayless, and replace the bridge decks at River Des Peres, the Union Pacific Railroad, Gravois Creek, and Green Park. Project continues through summer 2024.
