


THE PROPOSAL

- \$1 billion of multimodal projects




2022-2026 STIP CONTRACTOR AWARDS AND FUTURE FUNDING STRATEGIES



— — — Potential program level







THE FEEDBACK

- 442 public comments
- 282 desired projects have already been identified as unfunded needs
- 95 comments identifying 48 additional needs
- 65 comments related to off system needs, MoDOT
 policy and other items





THE TRENDS

- 100+ comments on widening I-49
 - Corridor improvements identified as tier
 3 project
- Dozens of bike/ped comments
 - Many requesting funding for the Rock Island Trail
 - DNR announced in December plans to complete the trail



- Finalize sharing comments with partners
 - Ensures inclusion in local level prioritization
 - Assists identifying other jurisdictions' needs
- Start again after STIP
 - Annually collect and then prioritize
 - Continue to work to get more involvement
 - Continue steps to further refine and standardize prioritization process
