## MINUTES OF THE HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION MEETING HELD VIA TELECONFERENCE AND IN JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, THURSDAY, JANUARY 20, 2022

A special meeting of the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission was held on Thursday, January 20, 2022, by teleconference at the Missouri Department of Transportation, 105 W. Capitol Avenue, Jefferson City, Missouri. Robert G. Brinkmann, P.E., Chair, called the meeting to order at 4:45 p.m. The following Commissioners were present via teleconference: John W. Briscoe, Gregg C. Smith, Michael T. Waters, Jr., Terry L. Ecker, and W. Dustin Boatwright, P.E.

The meeting was called pursuant to Section 226.120 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended. The Commission was informed that this meeting had been posted at 1:30 p.m. on January 20, 2022, which is less than 24 hours in advance of the meeting as required by Section 610.020 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. Pursuant to that statute, the Commission determined that it was necessary and in the public interest to hold this meeting on less than 24 hour notice and that there is good cause such notice is impossible or impractical. Due to the receipt of a letter requesting the resignation of the Director and Deputy Director and the need for the Commission to meet as soon as practical upon receipt of the letter, it is necessary to hold this meeting with less than 24 hour notice of this meeting.
