## **Examples of Work**

- (1) Provides direction to district and division staff regarding right of way, outdoor advertising, and junkyards.
- (2) Approves and executes lease agreements, excess property sales, and administrative settlements.
- (3) Executes offer letters, acquisition payrolls, sales agreements, and right of way fee services contracts.
- (4) Drafts, reviews, interprets, and negotiates unique right of way contracts and agreements.
- (5) Approves conditional and partial right of way clearance certifications to advance projects to letting.
- (6) Approves policy waiver requests; approves modifications and additions to the right of way, local program administration right of way, outdoor advertising, and junkyard sections of the division.
- (7) Negotiates lease agreements with the Missouri State Office of Administration for the Highway Patrol.
- (8) Responds to legislative requests; meets with legislators, testifies at legislative hearings, and approves fiscal note responses.
- (9) Performs supervisory responsibilities in a manner consistent with the department's Affirmative Action Program.
- (10) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.

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
