<b>General Summary</b>	The assistant transportation planning director directs and supervises transportation planning functions related to planning and performance, system analysis, and statewide programming. Responsibilities are performed under general supervision.
<b>Minimum/Required Qualifications</b>	Bachelor's Degree: Accounting, Business Administration, Civil Engineering, Finance, Planning, Public Administration, or related field  Over nine years of experience in planning, or in highway or transportation engineering, including positions demonstrating a knowledge and application of transportation planning laws, regulations, policies, and procedures.
<b>Supervisory Responsibilities</b>	Full Supervision
<b>Location</b>	Central Office - Transportation Planning
<b>Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics</b>	Registration as a Certified Planner or as a Professional Engineer in the State of Missouri is preferred.

## **Examples of Work**

- (1) Plans and directs the planning and performance, transportation system analysis, and statewide programming units with an emphasis on performance-based planning and programming.
- (2) Prepares the division business and work plans to ensure completion of projects.
- (3) Assists the transportation planning director in developing and administering statewide transportation planning policies, procedures, and initiatives.
- (4) Represents the division or the department at internal and external meetings and conferences; meets with internal or external groups to discuss transportation planning issues, projects, or policies.
- (5) Develops and oversees performance measures related to transportation planning.
- (6) Prepares and monitors the division budget and approves expenditures.
- (7) Performs supervisory responsibilities in a manner consistent with the department's Affirmative Action Program.
- (8) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
