Examples of Work

- (1) Oversees the reviewing, estimating and distribution of plans, proposals and other project information for all department projects.
- (2) Oversees the electronic systems that process plans, proposals and bids.
- (3) Oversees the departments bid openings to ensure that all legal and bid opening requirements are met.
- (4) Supervises staff and assists them with career development and furthering skills in estimating, review of design and utilization of software and publishing of bid information on the web.
- (5) Prepares and reviews all reports for management and the Commission on the department's bid opening and other bidding and contracting related issues.
- (6) Assists Districts and Central Office staff with final project design details, scheduling, innovative contracting and other technical details of project delivery.
- (7) Serves as the department's contact with contractors regarding bidding and contract related issues.
- (8) Serves as the division's pavement contact attending quarterly meetings, recommending design changes and working with alternate bidding on the pavement team.

- (9) Serves as the department's representative for national bidding and contracting related issues.
- (10) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
