General Summary

The bridge inspection crew member performs general/visual and in-depth inspection of bridges. Responsibilities are performed under direct supervision.

Minimum/Required Qualifications

- High School Diploma or GED/HiSET
- Valid Class B Commercial Driver's License with no air brake restrictions and interstate status (either Excepted Interstate [EI] or Non-Excepted [NI]).
- Employee will be required to pass a cardiopulmonary function test yearly, attend training on the use of respirators, and pass a respirator fit test every six months.
- Successful completion of a work simulation examination and a medical-physical examination.

Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics

- Requires continuous, overnight, statewide travel.
- Requires significant physical stamina and endurance.
- Requires exposure to physical hazards, health and safety risks, and/or adverse or otherwise undesirable characteristics in the environment.
- May require operation of vehicles to plow snow and spread ice control materials.

Examples of Work

- 1. Operates under-bridge inspection and related equipment to visually examine bridges for cracks, fractures, and deterioration.
- **2.** Assists in preparing reports and other documentation related to general and in-depth bridge inspection.
- **3.** Sets up traffic control devices such as signs, flags, cones, and arrow boards; performs flagging responsibilities for traffic through work zones.
- **4.** Conducts equipment safety checks; performs preventative maintenance on vehicles and equipment, including monitoring fluids, greasing and oiling parts, cleaning, and making minor repairs.
- **5**. Operates vehicles to transport crew, equipment, and materials to job site.
- **6.** May assist routine maintenance crews with snow removal activities, including plowing snow and spreading ice control materials.
- 7. Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
