General Summary

The core drill superintendent directs and coordinates statewide drilling activities necessary to obtain material samples and data for subsurface investigations.

Responsibilities are performed under general supervision.

Minimum/Required Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED/HiSET.
- Department of Natural Resources Certification for monitoring well installations.
- Eight years of experience in all phases of exploration drilling.
- OSHA 10-Hour Certification required within 90 days.

Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics

- Job requires frequent, statewide, overnight travel.
- Job requires exposure to moderately adverse and undesirable environmental conditions.
- Job may require operation of vehicles to plow snow and spread ice control materials.

Examples of Work

 Establishes job priorities for drilling requests; schedules and assigns work by coordinating with the geotechnical and district personnel; and establishes and maintains a budge for personnel, equipment, and materials.

- 2. Maintains records for drilling personnel, equipment usage, and time reporting.
- 3. Maintains inventory records, reviews pavement thickness reports for accuracy as governed by the materials manual and federal regulations, and prepares summary reports.
- **4.** Performs general field inspections to ensure proper drilling procedures, maintenance of equipment, and training of personnel; and consults with district personnel on problems or special assignments.
- 5. Consults with outside vendors and contractors for services, new drilling equipment, and materials.
- **6.** Investigates new drilling methods; provides recommendations regarding specifications for new drilling equipment or the fabrication or modification of existing drilling equipment.
- **7.** Performs supervisory responsibilities in a manner consistent with the department's equal opportunity policies.
- 8. Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
