General Summary

The structural technician performs entry-level technical or paraprofessional duties in the preparation of detailed construction plans for highway bridges and related structures. Responsibilities are performed under moderate supervision.

Minimum/Required Qualifications

• Associate's Degree in Civil Engineering Technology, Drafting, or related field.

Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics

 A postsecondary degree is the best measure to ensure candidates possess required knowledge in computer aided drafting; trigonometry, geometry, and physics; statics and strength of materials; surveying concepts; material quantity calculations, takeoffs, and unit pricing; and dimensioning concepts.

Examples of Work

- 1. Prepares detailed construction plans for routine bridges, retaining walls and box culverts using computer aided drafting systems.
- 2. Computes elevations and structural dimensions from sketches and computations supplied by a designer.
- 3. Makes necessary revisions after plans have been checked or reviewed.
- 4. Computes reinforcing bar lists and quantities of materials needed for construction.

- **5.** Prepares preliminary detailing for new projects.
- **6.** Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
