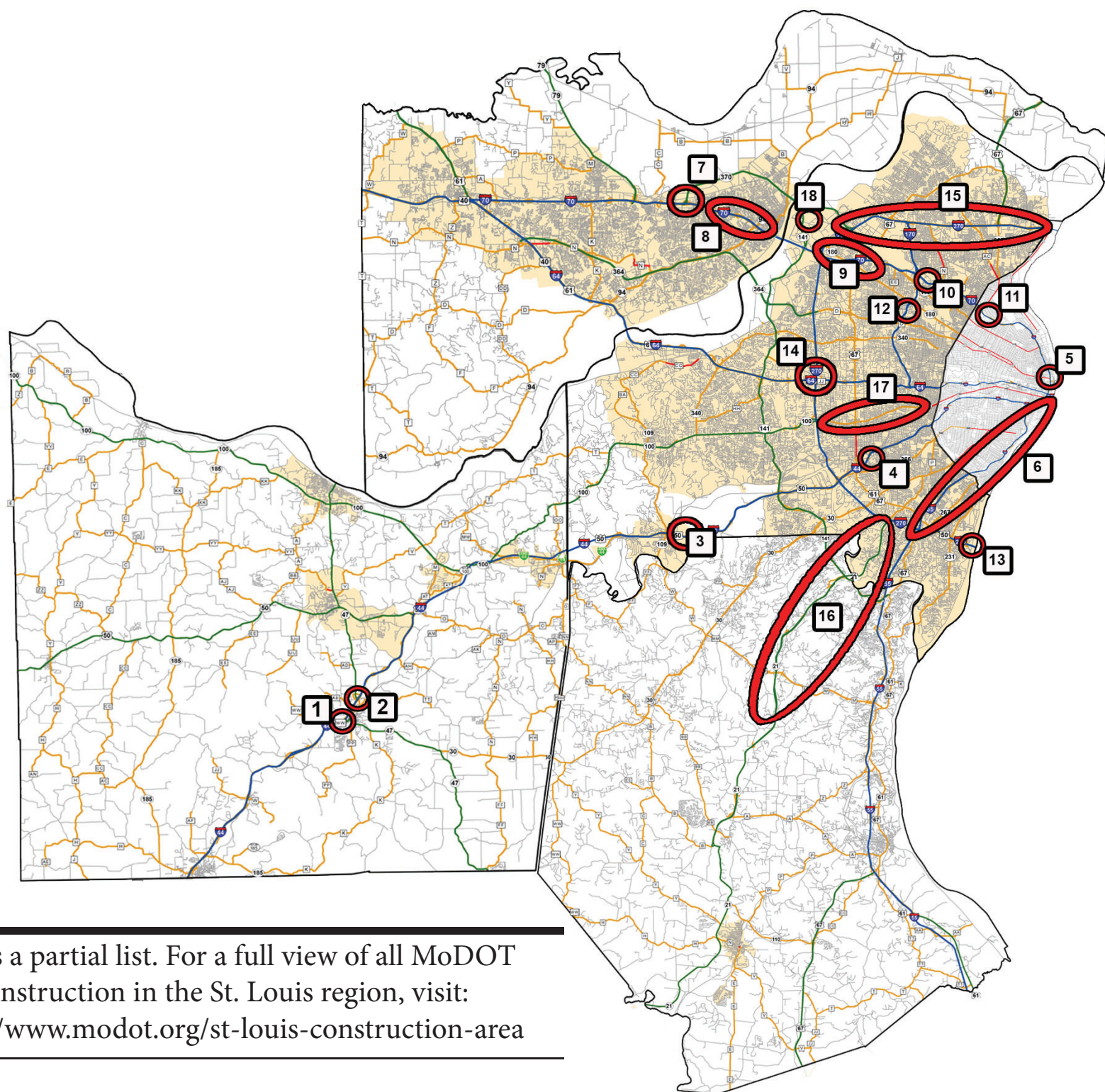


# 2022 St. Louis area Major Work Zones

- 1. I-44 at Route 30, Franklin County** -- Bridge and ramp improvements over I-44. Work requires full closures of both directions of I-44 for demolition. All ramps and Route 30 over I-44 traffic closed September to November.
- 2. I-44 at Route 47, Franklin County** – Bridge and ramp improvements over I-44. Work requires two full closures of I-44 for demolition. All ramps closed from April to September. Route 47 will be reduced to one lane in each direction on the bridge over I-44 at that time.
- 3. I-44 bridge rehabilitations, St. Louis County** – This project rehabilitates the two bridges over the Meramec River west of Lewis Road. Drivers can expect significant lane closures and narrowed and shifted lanes in each direction. While westbound traffic is shifted onto the shoulder, the ramp from Lewis Road to westbound I-44 will be closed.
- 4. I-44 Bridge replacement, St. Louis County** – This project removes and replaces the Big Bend Bridge over I-44. The Big Bend bridge is closed from April to August 2022. I-44 will be closed in both directions for two weekends to demolish the bridge and to set girders.
- 5. I-44 bridge replacement, St. Louis City** – Replaces the Broadway bridge over I-44 and the ramp from the I-70 express lanes onto Broadway. Southbound Broadway is closed over the interstate until summer 2023. Drivers can expect narrowed and shifted lanes on I-44 and the express lanes and the ramp from Biddle to eastbound I-44 to be closed through fall 2022.
- 6. I-55 bridge improvements, St. Louis City and St. Louis County** – This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 into the city. Drivers can expect narrowed and shifted lanes between Arsenal and Lindbergh, including two lanes of both northbound and southbound traffic sharing one side of the interstate between Potomac and Pestolozzi. Crews will close the interstate over a weekend to demolish a pedestrian bridge north of Reavis Barracks
- 7. I-70/Route 370 Interchange, St. Charles County** – Rehabilitate six bridges at I-70/Route 370 interchange. Drivers can expect lane closures on the interstates and outer roads.
- 8. I-70 from Fairgrounds to Cave Springs, St. Charles County** – Interchange improvements. Drivers can expect lane closures on the interstates and outer roads. Project website: <https://www.i70csfg.com/>
- 9. I-70 bridge improvements, St. Louis County** – Updates the McDonnell Blvd. and Lambert International Blvd. ramps onto eastbound I-70. This work will include lane and ramp closures.

- 10. I-70 - Bridge rehabilitations on the Hanley and Bermuda bridges, St. Louis County** – This work will include lane and ramp closures.
- 11. I-70 bridge repair, St. Louis City** – Bridge repairs on the East Taylor bridge over I-70. Will require two weekend closures of I-70 in the area.
- 12. I-170 bridge improvements, St. Louis County** -- Bridge improvements on the Midland and Lackland bridges over I-170. Midland and Lackland will be closed over the interstate, with detours, during the project.
- 13. I-255 bridge rehabilitation, St. Louis County** – Rehabilitates the I-255 bridge across the Mississippi River (the Jefferson Barracks Bridge) and rehabilitates the Koch Road bridge on the interstate. This year, the eastbound bridge will be closed. One lane of traffic in each direction will be closed and the remaining two lanes of eastbound traffic will be shifted to the westbound bridge.
- 14. I-270 bridge replacement, St. Louis County** – This project rehabilitates the ramp bridges at the I-270 and I-64 interchange and replaces and widens the I-270 bridge over Conway just north of the I-64 interchange. Work primarily focuses on the Ladue Road bridge and the I-64 ramps this year. Work on I-270 over the I-64 ramps will be over a weekend and will require I-270 to be reduced to two lanes.
- 15. I-270 North Corridor Project, St. Louis County** – Various improvements to I-270 from I-70 to the Chain of Rocks Bridge. Crews anticipate replacing four bridges along the corridor this year, which will require narrowed and shifted lanes and long term roadway closures. - 16. Route 21 from Route 30, St. Louis County, to Schenk Road, Jefferson County** – Rehabilitate bridges, resurfacing, signal, guardrail and ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) upgrades.
- 17. Route 100 roadway improvements, St. Louis County** – Two projects this year update signals and drainage between Big Bend and I-270, and update sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements in that area. Signal, drainage and ADA work requires lane closures in both directions during non-peak hour traffic. This summer, both directions of Route 100 will be closed west of Hanley to replace the Black Creek Bridge. This closure is expected to last about four months.
- 18. Route 141, St. Louis County** – Bridge replacements in Earth City between Shoreline Drive and Lakefront Drive. This work will include complete closures of those bridges for up to six months with detours.
