Applicants must present valid documentation for proof of selected base

jurisdiction as a resident or established place of business.

Missouri Residency

Three (3) proofs of residency with Missouri physical addresses are required.

You must provide the following two (2) documents:

- Valid resident driver's license, or non-driver jurisdiction issued identification
- ^D Personal Property Tax Receipt or Waiver

Choose from the list below. Proofs must show a Missouri physical address:

- Current utility bill
- ^D Title
- ^D Tax filing document
- Voter registration card
- Bank statement
- EIN papers

Missouri Established Place of Business

You must provide the following proof/documentation:

- Lease paperwork listing applicant, no less than 12-month duration, or other ownership documentation
- Posted hours of operation
- Open for business a minimum of 20 hours per week on a permanent basis.
- Staffed by an employee, may be verified by employee's pay stub.

Virtual or shared office spaces do not qualify.

- **Required Documents**
 - ^D Title or title receipt
 - Equipment lease agreement, required if titled owner is any name other than account name Lease must include:
 - VIN
 - Make
 - Vehicle year
 - Lessor name, lessee name
 - Signatures of both parties
 - ^D Personal property tax receipt or waiver
 - ^D IRS form 2290

Submit for all units over 55,000 lbs., must be watermarked or stamped by IRS office

*If you have an active DOR plate registered in the same legal name, you **may** be eligible to receive a credit towards an apportioned plate. The plate registration document must be uploaded at the time of application.

Before Applying for an MCE Account:

- ✓ Ensure business name is properly registered with the Missouri Secretary of State
- ✓ Motor Carrier USDOT number must be active and in good standing
- ✓ File and pay Unified Carrier Registration for USDOT Number if applicable
