PROPOSED RESCISSION

7 CSR 60-1.070 Motorcycle Requirements. This rule outlined the standards for motorcycles used in an approved motorcycle rider training program.

PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded to update the Motorcycle Safety Education Program with current practices.

AUTHORITY: section 302.134, RSMo Supp. 1999. This rule originally filed as 11 CSR 60-1.070. Original rule filed March 20, 1996, effective Sept. 30, 1996. Amended: Filed Nov. 22, 1999, effective May 30, 2000. Moved to 7 CSR 60-1.070, effective Aug. 28, 2003. Rescinded: September 9, 2022.*
