



MODOT IS HIRING EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL FOR THE 2024-25 WINTER SEASON

Our emergency maintenance operators are on hand to answer the call when winter weather and other emergencies threaten our state's highways.

Currently, there are several emergency maintenance equipment operator positions open for qualified drivers to handle winter/emergency maintenance operations across the Show-Me State.

Salaries start at \$22.69 an hour and depend on level of experience and area of operation. This is an on-call position – hours will vary depending on weather events. The hourly rate is dependent on area of operation and seasons plowing, with an additional \$1 hour for night work (7 p.m. – 7 a.m.).

If you're a service-oriented individual who is at least 18 years old and can successfully complete a criminal background check (a misdemeanor or felony conviction is not an automatic bar to employment) and drug screening, MoDOT wants you to consider a career working to keep Missouri moving this winter. Applicants must have a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL).
