



FULL STEAM AHEAD

In 2015, we created the Olsson Foundation, which supports organizations and groups aimed at improving the lives of the people we serve. The Olsson Foundation selects nonprofit organizations that help youth experience the outdoors; science, technology, engineering, the arts, and math (STEAM) programming; educational opportunities, and more.

Implementing Safety in Missouri

The City of Kansas City's *Vision Zero KC* program was created to focus on creating safer streets and eliminating traffic injuries and fatalities in Kansas City neighborhoods.

Olsson worked with the city to identify how to improve bike connections between the University of Missouri-Kansas City and downtown. The project focused on Gillham Road, a four-lane and six-lane boulevard with intermittent onstreet parking that experiences 12,000 to 16,000 vehicles per day. Gillham Road connects several large parks and historical, active neighborhoods.

Working closely with the city, as well as neighborhood associations, bicycling groups, institutions, and developers, we developed bicycling facilities that preserved on-street parking while increasing the protection and comfort level of bicyclists moving along the corridor.
