Sealed bids for Ridgemont Bridge – Over County House Branch project shall be received at 701 East Broadway, Columbia, MO until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 14 day of June, at the City of Columbia, Purchasing – Conference Room 1-C, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a sealed response.

The proposed work includes: to remove old 5-ton restricted bridge and replace with new bridge to specifications herein.

Pre-Bid Conference: The pre-bid conference will be held May 25, 2023 at 10:00 am, to address questions and concerns regarding the bid specifications and bid documents and view the site, if needed. All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Columbia/MoDOT hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Columbia/MoDOT, reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 4%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
