Improve I-70 Communications Lead

The Missouri Department of Transportation is seeking a Communications Lead for the statewide Improve I-70 Program. This program includes the planning, design, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, and repair of three lanes in each direction on approximately 200 miles of I-70.

The Communications Lead will coordinate all communications and media related to the Improve I-70 Program. Expected duties include the development of proactive communications plans, publications, materials and activities used to communicate information to the public, officials, and employees, as well as gather feedback. The Communications Lead provides strategic input on daily operational decisions, including developing communication strategies on critical issues.

Requirements to be Considered

- Bachelor's Degree: Communications, Journalism, Public Relations, Marketing or related field.
- Six years of experience in communications related positions.
- Submission of supporting letter detailing your work history related to:
