The *General Services Department* of Kansas City, Missouri will receive sealed Bids until 2:00 PM, on Tuesday, September 26th, 2023 at 414 E 12<sup>th</sup> Street, 1st Floor Room 102W, City Hall, Kansas City, Missouri, 64106 for <u>Project</u> No. 89008516, STP No. 3301(509) Wornall Road Reconstruction – 74<sup>th</sup> to 79<sup>th</sup> Streets. Bids will be opened after that time at the same location.

Bidding Documents will be available online to all interested parties at the Kansas City, Missouri Plan Room, <u>http://www.kcmoplanroom.org</u>. <u>All addenda will be posted at this location</u>. Any document or plan may be viewed or downloaded from this location.

The proposed work includes the reconstruction of Wornall Road from 74<sup>th</sup> Street to 79<sup>th</sup> Street. Work also includes reconstruction of parking lots at intersection of 75<sup>th</sup> Street and Wornall Road. This project includes substantial storm water infrastructure. The project is located in Kansas City, Jackson County, MO.

This project is funded in part with funds offered by the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT). The City of Kansas City, Missouri, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

<u>Prior to Bidding</u>, Subcontractors utilized for DBE Goals must appear on the MoDOT/Kansas City Approved DBE List and on the MoDOT DBE Directory located at http://www.modot.mo.gov/business/<u>contractor\_resources/bid\_opening</u> <u>info/bidGenInfo.shtml</u>. The DBE goal for this project is **7%** and has 1 OJT.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

- Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.
- All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Each bidder must certify that it is not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any federal agency.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid price shall be submitted with each bid.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

A **Pre-Bid Conference** will be held on Tuesday, September 12, 2023, at 1:30pm in the GSD 17<sup>th</sup> Floor Conference Room-West located at 414 E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64106. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is encouraged for all Bidders on this Project.
