 - Based on 5000 personnel hours (prime + sub).
 - No specific project assigned.
 - Agreement based on Scope of Services and Proposed list of projects. (Various, Various, Urban).
 - Scoring changes.

Rating Criteria w/Weighted Values Project Understanding & Innovation Past Performance Qualifications of Personnel Assigned General Experience of Firm Familiarity/Capability Accessibility of Firm & Staff 20 Points Max 20 Points Max 20 Points Max 20 Points Max 100 Points Max

Qualified Consultants will be scored by District Construction and Design staff.
 Scores will be ranked from highest to lowest with negotiations starting with the highest scoring consultant.

• The selected consultant will be asked to provide an Exhibit III – Cost Estimate based on: • 5000 personnel hours (prime + sub) • Provided scope of services • If in agreement, then will use to establish "Not to Exceed" agreement cost. • If an agreement is not reached, will cease negotiations and go to the next consultant. • Three (3) consultants will be selected.

• Each consultant guaranteed at least one project.
No guarantee of using all hours/budget for season.

• As contractor schedules become available, projects with need will be assigned and obligated (Cost Estimate for selected project).

• As project reaches conclusion and other needs arise additional project inspections will be assigned and obligated.

• Once consultant nears the "Not to Exceed" limit of their Agreement, work will be concluded.
