Location: U.S. Route 54 eastbound from Main Street to the U.S. Route 63/ Missouri Route 94 interchange in Cole and Callaway counties. Traffic impact: The road will remain open and work will take place during nighttime hours. Budget: \$3 million. Construction expected start: 2024.

PROJECT DETAILS

Improvements are needed to create a safer, more efficient, and more reliable flow for the high volume of traffic using U.S. Route 54 in North Jefferson City. Around 56,000 vehicles travel along U.S. Route 54 between Main Street and the U.S. Route 63/Missouri Route 94 interchange each day.

This project includes:

- Restriping eastbound U.S. Route 54 over the Missouri River to four lanes.
- Adding a third lane of travel to eastbound U.S. Route 54 from the Missouri River bridge to U.S. Route 63.
- Adding auxiliary lanes to the eastbound ramp terminal at the U.S. Route 54/U.S. Route 63 interchange.
- Realigning the intersection of Wehmeyer Drive and Route 94 to the entrance of the Hitachi Energy, LLC.
