The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission is requesting the services of a consulting engineering firm to perform the described professional services for the project included on the attached list.

If your firm would like to be considered for these consulting services, you may express your interest by responding to the appropriate office, which is indicated on the attachments. Limit your letter of interest to no more than four pages. Two firms will be selected and the length of the cooridor will be split into two sections as indicated in the attached sheet. This letter should include a statement to indicate your firm's understanding of the project. It should also include any other information which might help us in the selection process, including key personnel you would assign to the project and the backgrounds of those individuals, and any sub-consultants you would propose to use, and an indication of your firm's approach to promoting and developing a diverse workforce. MoDOT is committed to reflecting the diversity of the communities we serve and we expect our partners to do the same. We will utilize the consultant information already on file so we will not need a lengthy submittal of other general company information. In addition, please attach one page with detailed information on similar projects that your key personnel have worked on. Indicate the role your key personnel played in the projects and include reference contact information.

DBE firms must be certified by the Missouri Department of Transportation in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any projects they feel can be managed by their firm. We also encourage both DBE firms and non-DBE firms to consider joining MoDOT's Mentor/Protégé program whenever possible as part of a MoDOT project.

MoDOT will evaluate and select two firms based on: Project Understanding & Innovation, Past Performance, Qualifications of Personnel Assigned, General Experience of Firm, Familiarity/Capability, and Accessibility of Firm & Staff. Firm's not providing a response on approach to workforce diversity will be considered non-responsive to this solicitation. Firm's that are not current on all of the required prequalification categories found in MoDOT's Approved Consultant Prequalification List at the date of the solicitation expiration will be considered non-responsive.

We request all letters be received by 3:00 pm, November 6, 2023 at the appropriate office.

Location:	From Oklahoma state line to Exit 257 in Pacific	
Proposed Improvement:	Two consultant teams will be selected to split the 9 counties that I-44 extends through in the project limits. The 2008 Study (I-44 Planning for Progress   Missouri Department of Transportation (modot.org)) divided the corridor into 7 sections, the two consultant teams selected will split these sections with one taking Sections 1-4 and the other taking Sections 5-7. The consultant teams will provide professional, technical, and other items necessary to complete the following. The selected teams will be expected to cooperate and coordinate when necessary to ensure consistent work and messaging for the corridor:	
	<ul> <li>The consultant teams will be expected to validate and/or update of the Purpose and Need statement, logical termini and independent utility sections within the I-44 Purpose and Need Study from 2008. This will include determination of current NEPA classification and obtaining concurrence from FHWA on both, with minor public involvement.</li> <li>The consultant firms will develop and complete a desktop GIS review of the corridor, recommendations of NEPA classes for the seven sections, and a construction prioritization of the seven sections. The top priority sections may continue through NEPA via a supplemental agreement of one or both teams.</li> </ul>	
	The consultants may also be asked to perform or check a high-level cost estimate, preliminary investigations such as as-builts, predictive safety analysis (using methods based on Highway Safety Manual 905.3 Transportation Impact Analysis - Engineering Policy Guide (modot.org)), traffic analysis, utility investigations, etc. to prepare for the NEPA phase of project development.  MoDOT will provide website content management, access to existing hotspot analysis for crash and delay history (Crash Statistics Map), flood studies, freight study data, and other specific traffic or roadway data or analysis available.	

	MoDOT will have a team consisting of District Representation from the St. Louis, Central and Southwest Districts, as well as Central Office staff from Environmental, Bridge, Design and Safety, Communications, and Traffic staff that will manage the contracts, provide data, and assist with	
	public involvement.
