RE: Request for Expression of Interest: **24ENGST1** - **STBG 7302(697)** – **Regency Parkway Reconstruction**

Dear Consultant:

The City of Saint Charles has interest in securing professional services for work associated with:

Regency Parkway Reconstruction

The proposed typical section maintains the same roadway width, but includes vertical curbs, 2.5-foot turf buffer, and 5-foot wide sidewalks with ADA curb ramps on both sides for added pedestrian safety. There will be two 11-foot travel lanes, one in each direction, with a two-way center turn lane to improve traffic safety and traffic flow through this commercial area. New streetlights will be placed at 4 major intersections for added safety. Additional safety items proposed are flashing LED stop signs at Plaza Way & Regency Parkway, increase triangle sight distance, and install an enhanced RRFB pedestrian crossing at a mid-block location. The new pavement section will consist of 9 inches concrete over 4 inches of aggregate base to provide a more durable roadway to support the large truck traffic. All driveway entrances will be replaced as well. The new typical section will remain within existing 50-foot right-of-way, though temporary easements are expected for construction. Traffic counts will also need to be collected to help determine if a future signal is warranted at Veterans Memorial Parkway and Regency Parkway.

Tentative Project Schedule:

Design NTP – January 2024 Final PS&E – December 2025 Bid Opening – March 2026 Construction Completed – March 2027

The estimated total cost of this project is \$3,150,00.00.

To be considered for this project your written response (mail or email, 2 written pages max.) must be received by no later than **2 p.m. on November 8, 2023**. In your letter, please describe why you are interested in the project and why you feel that you are most qualified to complete the proposed project. After all responses are received, City Staff will select the 3 most qualified firms based on scoring of your prequalification packet and your response letter.

- Experience in work required
- Record of the firm accomplishing the work on other projects in the required time
- QA/QC Program
- Recent experience showing accuracy of construction project cost estimates
- Project Management Philosophy and Approach

The selected 3 firms will then be requested to submit a qualifications based Request for Proposal (RFP) on the project. These proposals will be ranked and the project will then be negotiated with the highest rated firm.

Additional information relating to the proposed project scope will be distributed during the RFP stage of this project solicitation including the Project Charter. Staff will not address project specific questions during the expression of interest solicitation but will during the RFP stage.

It is the responsibility of the consultant to ensure their prequalification packet is up-to-date. Updates or supplements to the prequalification packet that are to be considered in the current scoring will be accepted up to one week prior to the EOI submittal deadline. It is required that your firm's Statement of Qualification (RSMo 8.285 through 8.291) be submitted with your firm's Letter of Interest, or be on file with the City of St. Charles. The statement of qualification is not included in the total page count limit.

DBE firms must be listed in the MRCC DBE Directory located on MoDOT's website at www.modot.gov, in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any project they feel can be managed by their firm.

The DBE PE Goal for this project is: 12%

It is required that your firm be prequalified with MoDOT and listed in MoDOT's Approved Consultant Prequalification List, or your firm will be considered non-responsive.
