



PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Construction: Planned for 2024. **Location:** Callaway County Route BB northwest of Tebbets.

Traffic impact: Full road closure (closed up to 50 days) with signed detour.

Cost estimate: \$632,000.
Average daily traffic:

Approximately 424 vehicles daily.





PROJECT DETAILS

Why is MoDOT planning changes?

The Callaway County Route BB bridge over Hillers Creek, north of Tebbetts, was built in 1968. The supporting structures of the bridge are in good condition, but the deck of the bridge has deteriorated to the point it needs to be replaced. During the project, the bridge rails will also be brought up to current standards. The bridge will be closed during the project and a signed detour will be in place.

How will traffic be impacted?

The bridge will be closed up to 50 days during construction and motorists will be directed around the closure over a signed detour route over Routes AA, 94 and PP.

What is the cost of the project?

The anticipated total cost for this project is \$632,000. This is subject to change.

When is MoDOT planning to make the improvements?

At this time, the project is expected to be part of MoDOT's January 2024 letting when contractors may submit competitive bids.

Construction is anticipated to take place in 2024, however the exact schedule of the 50-day closure has not yet been determined.

It is vital that stakeholders provide input during the open comment period (Nov. 8-22, 2023) to help the project team determine the parameters to build into the contract that will guide the contractor during the construction process.

As with all projects that are in the planning stage, these dates are subject to change.
