PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Construction: Planned to start in 2024 and continue up to 2025.

Location: Boone County Route 22,

124, and 151 intersection.

closures and temporary Route 151

closure with detour.

PROJECT DETAILS

Why is MoDOT planning changes?

Roundabouts greatly increase safety vs traditional intersections. The potential impact points for crashes, especially t-bone crashes, is greatly reduced, lowering the chance of a serious or fatal crash. The plans include improvements that will enhance safety, drivability, and traffic flow.

How will traffic be impacted?

Route 151 will be briefly closed to construct the north portion of the roundabout and will have a signed detour. Routes 22 and 124 will be staged to construct the remaining portions of the roundabout. At least one lane will remain open.

What is the cost of the project?

The anticipated total construction cost for this project is \$1.1m. This is subject to change.

When is MoDOT planning to make the improvements?

At this time, the project is expected to be part of MoDOT's May 2024 letting when contractors may submit competitive bids.

Construction is anticipated to take place in the summer of 2024, however the exact schedule of the traffic impact has not yet been determined.

It is vital that stakeholders provide input during the open comment period (Jan. 18-31, 2024) to help the project team determine the parameters to build into the contract that will guide the contractor during the construction process.

As with all projects that are in the planning stage, these dates are subject to change.
