

# 2024

**I-44 pavement update** – This project updates signals and resurfaces I-44 and the outer roadways between Williams Road and the Franklin County line. Project should be complete by summer 2024.

**I-55 bridge and pavement improvements**  
 – This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 between I-44 and Lindbergh. This year, crews will work between River Des Peres and Loughborough, as well as near Gravois Creek and Green Park Road, on the northbound and southbound lanes. Drivers can expect shifted traffic lanes between Lindbergh and Loughborough as crews remove and replace the driving surface on several bridges along that corridor. Cyclists can also expect a full closure of the Carondelet Connector south of Loughborough later in the year and short duration closures of the River Des Peres and Grants Trail greenways. Crews will pave portions of the interstate and associated interchanges as bridge work is completed. During resurfacing, crews will remove the ramp from Cherokee to southbound I-55 in the city of St. Louis. The project continues through mid-2025.

**I-270 bridge replacement** – This project replaces the I-270 bridge over Conway just north of the I-64 interchange. The project also widens and replaces the driving surface on the Ladue bridge on I-270. The project starts in early 2024 and should be complete by late 2025.

**Route 50/61/67 (Lindbergh) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to sidewalks along the corridor between Big Bend and Barracksview to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements and resurfaces the roadway. The roadway improvement project is underway and should be complete in summer 2025.


**Route 61/67 (Lindbergh) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signals, updates sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements and resurfaces the roadway between Swan Drive and Route D (Page Ave). Also includes a complete roadway closure in summer 2025 to remove and replace the bridge over Deer Creek. Project starts in 2024 and should be complete in late 2025.

**Route 100 roadway improvements** – This project updates signals and drainage between Lindbergh and I-270, and updates sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements in that area. When the work is complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work is currently underway and continues through late 2024.

**Route 109 at Route CC intersection improvements** – This project converts the Route 109 intersection with Route CC to a modified two-lane roundabout. Work starts in spring 2024 and continues until late 2025.

**Route 340 roadway improvements** – This project repairs pavement, makes updates to sidewalks and signals and resurfaces between Lea Oak and I-270. The project is currently underway and will be complete in 2024.

**Route 366 (Watson) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Geyer and the St. Louis city limits to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. The bridge over Gravois Creek will be replaced. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2024 and will be complete in late 2025.



**Route 100 (Manchester) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Route 141 and I-270 to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. Includes replacing culverts at Grand Glaize and Glaize creeks, and bridge maintenance at I-270 and over Des Peres Road. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2025 and will be complete in late 2026.

**Route 109 roadway improvements** – This project resurfaces the roadway between Route CC and Route 100. It also resurfaces all of Route BA (which goes from Route 109 to Babler Park). It starts in early 2025 and continues through the year.

**Route 141 roadway improvements** – This project makes several safety and traffic movement updates on the Route 141 and I-64 interchange. It also resurfaces the roadway between St. Luke’s Hospital Road and I-64. This project starts in early 2025 and continues through 2026.

**Route 231 roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between the city of St. Louis and Franru Lane to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced and restriped. In areas, lanes will be removed and repurposed, and in other areas lane widths will be reduced to help moderate traffic speeds. Construction starts in mid-2025 and continues into 2027.

**Route 231 roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Franru and the Meramec River to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2025 and will be complete in late 2026.

**Route 267 (Lemay Ferry) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Lindbergh and River City Boulevard to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2025 and will be complete in late 2026.

**Route 340 (Olive) roadway improvements** – This project resurfaces the roadway between I-270 and Dielman, and updates sidewalks, signals and crosswalks as necessary to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. Work starts in early 2025 and continues into early 2026.

**Route AB (Ladue) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signals, crosswalks and sidewalks between I-270 and Route 141 to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2025 and continues into early 2026.

**I-55 bridge and pavement improvements** – This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 between Loughborough and River Des Peres. Cyclists can also expect a full closure of the Carondelet Connector south of Loughborough and short duration closures of the River Des Peres greenway. During resurfacing, crews will remove the ramp from Cherokee to southbound I-55 in the city of St. Louis. The project continues through mid-2025.

**Route 21 roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signals and guardrail, updates sidewalks to meet Americans with
