The State of Missouri recognizes that a young adult cannot be fully independent without a driver's license. Having a license is particularly important for youth without a traditional family support network as it enables him or her to have a job, go to school, engage socially, and contribute to their community.

As part of Show-Me Zero, a strategic highway safety plan for eliminating fatalities and serious injuries, we strongly encourage our youth to be safe drivers by engaging in behind the wheel training. Keys to Independence MO creates opportunities and removes barriers to driving by financially supporting the cost of driving lessons for youth in out-of-home care.

REQUIREMENTS

- Youth must be residing in out-of-home care in the State of Missouri.
- Youth must be 15-23 years old.
- Youth must meet Graduate Driver's License Law and DMV requirements for learners permit and drivers license.
