

St. Louis City Construction — 2024-2025

2024

- I-44 bridge overlays** – This project continues to overlay portions of the I-44 Viaduct Bridge over Cole Street near downtown St. Louis city. Work should require overnight lane closures on this bridge.

- 2025 bridge and pavement improvements** – This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 between I-44 and Lindbergh. This year, crews will work between River Des Peres and Loughborough, as well as near Gravois Creek and Green Park Road, on the northbound and southbound lanes. Drivers can expect shifted traffic lanes between Lindbergh and Loughborough as crews remove and replace the driving surface on several bridges along that corridor. Cyclists can also expect a full closure of the Carondelet Connector south of Loughborough later in the year and short duration closures of the River Des Peres and Grants Trail greenways. Crews will pave the interstate and associated interchanges as bridge work is completed. During resurfacing, crews will remove the ramp from Cherokee to southbound I-55 in the city of St. Louis. The project continues through mid-2025.

- I-64 and I-44 debris netting** – Places debris netting and fencing under several bridges on I-44 along the interstate between 4th Street and 16th Street. Completed in 2024.

- I-64 bridge overlays** – This project seals cracks on and overlays the Compton Bridge over I-64. Work may require overnight lane closures on this bridge. Work continues through 2024.

- I-70 sign upgrades** – Structural signs along I-70 within the city limits will be inspected and upgraded to current safety and reflectivity standards. Work continues through early 2024

- I-70 pavement improvements** – This project makes various pavement repairs and updates the driving surface on the interstate between Goodfellow and Kingshighway. This project will remove some equipment and update median barriers and guardrail along the corridor.

- I-270 bridge construction** – Illinois Department of Transportation project. Constructs a new I-270 bridge across the Mississippi River north of city of St. Louis. Construction on the new bridge has begun, although initial traffic impacts should be minimal. Drivers can expect narrowed and shifted lanes within that section.

- Route 100 bridge overlays** – This project overlays the bridge at Route 100 east of Vandeventer. Work may require overnight lane closures on this bridge. Work continues through 2024.

- Route 367 pavement improvements** – This project updates the driving surface on the route from the Halls Ferry Circle to I-70 and makes safety improvements coordinated with the city of St. Louis. Work continues through 2025.

- Route H resurfacing** – Replaces the driving surface along Route H (Hall St) between Adelaide and Riverview and makes safety improvements coordinated with the city of St. Louis. This project includes lane reductions along the corridor.

2025

- I-55 sign updates** – This project reviews and replaces overhead signs along I-55 between the Poplar Street Bridge and the Ste. Genevieve County line.

- I-55 bridge and pavement improvements** – This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 between Loughborough and River Des Peres. Cyclists can also expect a full closure of the Carondelet Connector south of Loughborough and short duration closures of the River Des Peres Greenway. During resurfacing, crews will remove the ramp from Cherokee to southbound I-55 in the city of St. Louis. The project continues through mid-2025.

- I-64 pavement improvement** – This project overlays the existing roadway between Sara Street and 22nd Street.

- Route 100 pavement improvements** – This project resurfaces Route 100 between the St. Louis City limits and I-55. This work includes safety improvements along the corridor coordinated with the city of St. Louis.
