

MISSOURI ROUTE 179 OVER MONITEAU CREEK BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

The supporting structures of the Route 179 bridge over Moniteau Creek are in good condition, but the driving surface – the deck – has deteriorated and must be replaced. Planned improvements include:

- A new 28-foot wide deck - the same width as the existing structure.
- New bridge barriers to replace the current railing.
- New guardrail at all four corners.
- Additional work to take place on the supporting structures at the ends of the bridge - the end bents.

Traffic Impacts

- The bridge will be closed for the duration of construction, which is anticipated to last 65 consecutive days.
- Message boards will give at least one week advanced notice before the closure.
- A signed detour will be in place directing motorists to use Missouri Route 87 and Route N.
- At the discretion of the contractor, Route 179 over Moniteau Creek can be closed simultaneously with Route U over Howard Creek.



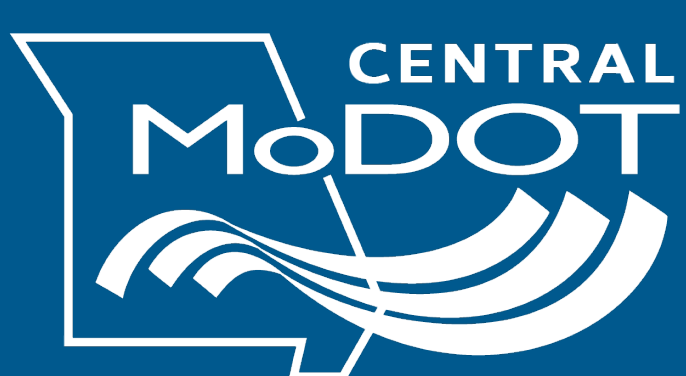
Current Project Timeline

- **November 2024:** Contractors submit competitive bids.
- **December 2024:** Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract for work.
- **January 2025:** Earliest the contractor may begin work.
- **End of 2025:** Anticipated completion of project.

Estimated Cost

- \$1.245 million including engineering and construction costs.*
