

MISSOURI ROUTE 43/ELK RIVER BRIDGE REPLACEMENT McDONALD COUNTY



- Replace Missouri Route 43 bridge over Elk River west of Anderson
- New bridge will be thirty (30) feet longer, six (6) feet wider, one (1) foot higher than current bridge
- Stabilize stream bank northeast of bridge





- Construction to begin spring 2026
- Estimated Total Cost: \$5.4 million
- Cowskin Access will remain OPEN for the duration of the project

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Route 43 CLOSED over Elk River for up to five (5) months during construction
- Detour: Missouri routes 90. 59 & 76




- Bridge built in 1960
- Bridge carries 1,500 vehicles a day
- Current bridge is in deteriorating condition in frequent need of maintenance
