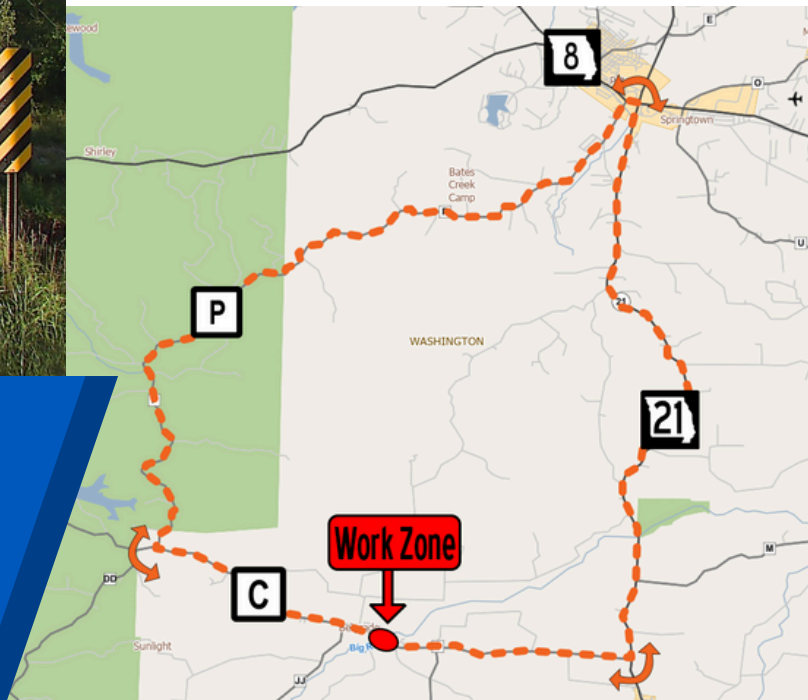

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Construction: Expected summer 2025.

Location: Washington County in Belgrade.

Traffic impact: Route C at the bridge will be closed during construction.

Project estimate: \$2.7 Million.

Average daily traffic:
Approximately 619 vehicles daily.

Why is MoDOT planning changes?

The existing Route C bridge over Big River was built in 1934, is currently narrower than the existing road, and the deck and barriers are showing signs it is nearing the end of its life cycle. The new structure will be up to current standards with a wider bridge deck, upgraded approaches, and new guardrail which will improve the drivability and safety for motorists.

How will traffic be impacted?

The contractor will close the bridge to all traffic through the completion of the project. A signed detour will be posted using Route P, Route 8, and Route 21.

What is the cost of the project?

The anticipated total construction and engineering cost for this project is \$2.7 Million. This is subject to change.

When is MoDOT planning to make the improvements?

At this time, the project is expected to be part of MoDOT's December 2024 letting when contractors may submit competitive bids.

Construction is anticipated to start in the summer of 2025; however, the exact schedule has not yet been determined.

As with all projects that are in the planning stage, these dates are subject to change.
