

U.S. ROUTE 54 BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

over U.S. Route 50 and McCarty Street



WHAT

Bridge rehabilitations on two 60-year-old overpasses in Jefferson City.



WHERE

Half-mile section between south of the Missouri River and Missouri Boulevard.



WHEN

Starting July 15

Phase 1 + Phase 2 = 90 days.



TRAFFIC IMPACT

U.S. Route 54 narrowed to a single lane of traffic, each direction, for 0.5 miles



STARTING JULY 15

For the first phase of work:

- Beginning south of the Missouri River, westbound traffic will shift to a head-to-head configuration with eastbound traffic.
- All ramps are expected to remain open.
- The eastbound lane will be reduced to 10 feet, while westbound will be 15 feet wide. The speed limit will be reduced to 35 miles per hour through the work zone.
- Legal width for all vehicles, including RVs and boats, is 8 feet, 6 inches.

STARTING JULY 8

Some of the rehabilitation work will be completed underneath both overpasses with no impact to traffic on U.S. Route 54.

Construction crews will use overnight, single-lane closures on U.S. Route 50 and McCarty Street the week of July 8, prior to the traffic shift.
