



U.S. ROUTE 54 BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

over U.S. Route 50 and McCarty Street



WHAT

Bridge rehabilitations to extend the life to two vital overpasses in Jefferson City.



WHERE

Half-mile section between south of the Missouri River and Missouri Boulevard.



WHEN

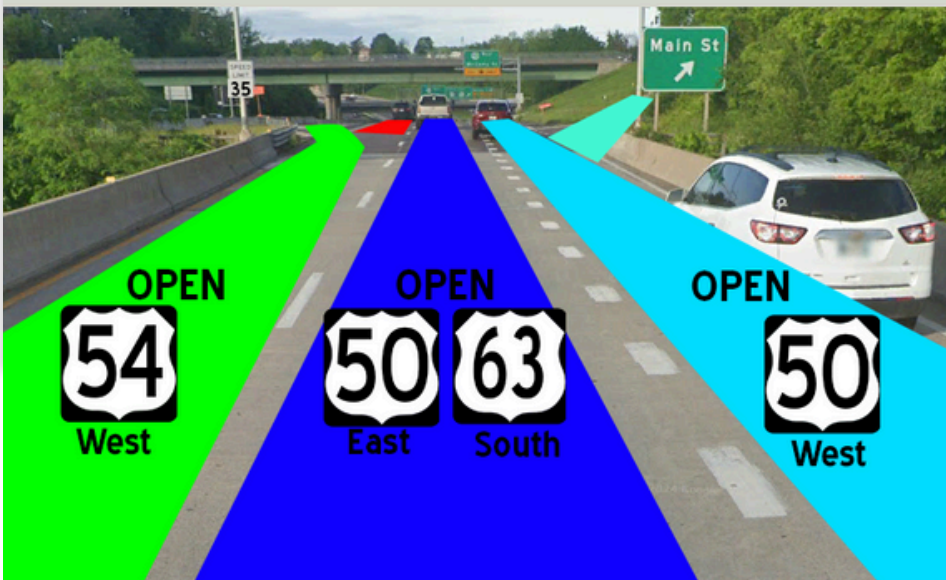
Starting July 15 at 7 p.m.
Phase 1 + Phase 2 = 90 days.



TRAFFIC IMPACT

U.S. Route 54 narrowed to a single lane of traffic, each direction, for 0.5 miles

Westbound U.S. Route 54 traffic shift SOUTH of the Missouri River Bridge



STARTING JULY 15

For the first phase of work, westbound traffic will shift to a head-to-head configuration with eastbound traffic, while the westbound bridges are repaired.

All ramps are expected to remain open during Phase 1. If needed for safety reasons, they may not be available at all times.

The speed limit will be reduced to 35 mph throughout the work zone.

A 15-foot width restriction will be in place for **westbound** U.S. Route 54.

A 10-foot width restriction will be in place for **eastbound** U.S. Route 54.

ALTERNATE ROUTES?

For travelers who drive this short section as part of their daily commute, avoiding peak travel times and planning for extra travel time will be the best course of action.

Those traveling from outside of the Jefferson City area to/from the Lake of the Ozarks region are encouraged to use an alternate route, such as those highlighted in blue (right). However, alternate routes will vary based on starting point and destination.
