



U.S. ROUTE 54 BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

over U.S. Route 50 and McCarty Street



WHAT

Bridge rehabilitations to extend the life to two vital overpasses in Jefferson City.



WHERE

Half-mile section between south of the Missouri River and Missouri Boulevard.



WHEN

Work began July 15.
Phase 1 + Phase 2 = 90 days.



TRAFFIC IMPACT

U.S. Route 54 narrowed to a single lane of traffic, each direction, for 0.5 miles



ONGOING: PHASE 1

On Friday, westbound traffic shifted to a head-to-head configuration with eastbound traffic.

YIELD WHEN YOU SEE 'YIELD' SIGN

During Phase I, all ramps are open. There is no merge area when entering eastbound U.S. Route 54 from Missouri Boulevard - be prepared to yield to U.S. Route 54 traffic.

SLOW DOWN

The speed limit is reduced to 35 mph throughout the work zone.

STAY IN YOUR LANE

To reduce congestion, drivers merging onto eastbound U.S. Route from U.S. Route 50 should stay in their lane until the solid white line ends.

Remember, by using all lanes of traffic until the merge point, you reduce the difference in speed between the two lanes and the length of backups is reduced 40-50 percent.
