The City of Knob Noster will evaluate firms based on a) experience and competence b) the capacity of the firm to perform the work in the timeframe needed c) past performance and d) proximity to and familiarity with the project area (23 CFR 172 - Administration of Engineering & Design Related Service Contracts and RSMo 8.285 through 8.291)

It is required that your firm's Statement of Qualification (RSMo 8.285 through 8.291) and an Affidavit of Compliance with federal work authorization program along with a copy of your firm's E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding (15 CSR 60-15.020) be submitted with your firm's Letter of Interest, or be on file with the City of Knob Noster. The statement of qualification is not included in the total page count limit.
