

U.S. ROUTE 54 BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

over U.S. Route 50 and McCarty Street



WHAT

Bridge rehabilitations to extend the life to two vital overpasses in Jefferson City.



WHERE

Half-mile section between south of the Missouri River and Missouri Boulevard.



WHFN

Phase 1 + Phase 2 = 90 days. Phase 1 began July 15.

Phase 2 to start mid-September.



TRAFFIC IMPACT

U.S. Route 54 narrowed to a single lane of traffic, each direction, for 0.6 miles.



PHASE 2

While we do not have a exact date, we anticipate the second phase of work to begin mid-September.

During this head-to-head configuration, all traffic will be pushed to westbound U.S. Route 54 while the eastbound bridges are repaired. Multiple ramps will be closed (see left and below).

The speed limit in the work zone will continue to be 35 mph. Width restrictions of 15 feet for westbound traffic and 10 feet for eastbound traffic will also remain in place.

RAMP CLOSURES

Phase 2 will include three ramp closures:

- Eastbound U.S. Route 54 to U.S. Route 50.
 - Use Missouri Boulevard to U.S. Route 50.
- Missouri Boulevard to eastbound U.S. Route 54.
 - Use westbound U.S. Route 50 to eastbound U.S. Route 54.
- Westbound U.S. Route 54 to West Main Street.
 - Use the exit ramp to McCarty Street.

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
