



U.S. ROUTE 54 BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

over U.S. Route 50 and McCarty Street



WHAT

Bridge rehabilitations to extend the life to two vital overpasses in Jefferson City.



WHERE

Half-mile section between south of the Missouri River and Missouri Boulevard.



WHEN

Phase 1 began July 15.
Phase 2 expected to start week of Sept. 16.



TRAFFIC IMPACT

U.S. Route 54 narrowed to a single lane of traffic, each direction, for 0.6 miles.

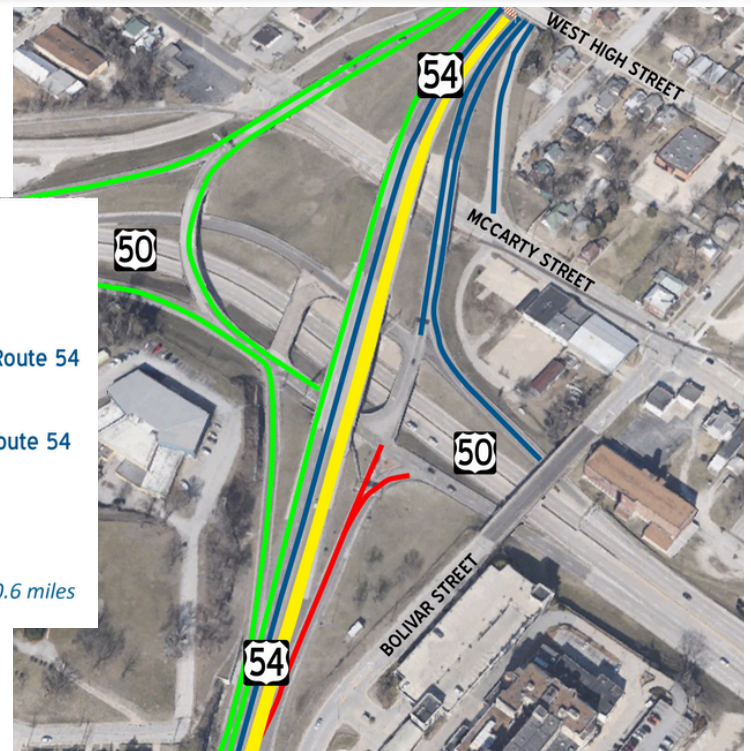
EXPECTED TO START WEEK OF SEPT. 16



LEGEND

- Work zone.
- Westbound U.S. Route 54 traffic.
- Eastbound U.S. Route 54 traffic.
- Ramp closed.

Length of traffic shift: 0.6 miles



For the second phase of work:

- Beginning near Missouri Boulevard, eastbound traffic will shift to a head-to-head configuration with westbound traffic.
- Three ramps will be CLOSED.
 - Missouri Boulevard to eastbound U.S. Route 54.
 - Eastbound U.S. Route 54 to U.S. Route 50
 - Westbound U.S. Route 54 to West Main Street.
- The speed limit in the work zone will continue to be 35 mph. Width restrictions of 15 feet for westbound traffic and 10 feet for eastbound traffic will also remain in place.
