Sealed bids for <u>West Essex Reconstruction STP-5502 (610)</u> will be received by 10:00 am local time on <u>November 1, 2024</u>. Bids will not be considered unless they are prepared in the City of Kirkwood's e-Procurement Platform, Ionwave, at <u>https://kirkwoodmo.ionwave.net</u>.

The proposed work includes the reconstruction of West Essex Avenue from North Kirkwood Road to North Geyer Road, including minor adjustments in vertical alignment and stormwater facilities to eliminate drainage issues and side street crowns. Improvements also include bump-outs to decrease pedestrian crossing distance, buffered bicycle lanes, and mid-block crossings,

All questions are due by <u>October 25, 2024</u>, and can only be submitted through the City of Kirkwood's e-procurement Platform, Ionwave, at https://kirkwoodmo.ionwave.net.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Kirkwood, at this moment, notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file seven days before the bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on a public works project provide a 10-hour OSHA construction safety program or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Kirkwood reserves the right to reject any or all bids. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsible bidder.

The DBE Goal for this project is **11%**.

No second-tier subcontracting will be allowed for this project.
