



U.S. ROUTE 54 BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

over U.S. Route 50 and McCarty Street



WHAT

Bridge rehabilitations to extend the life to two vital overpasses in Jefferson City.



WHERE

0.6 miles between just south of the Missouri River and Missouri Boulevard.



WHEN

Phase 1: July 15 - Sept. 16.
Phase 2: Sept. 17 -
week of Nov. 4.



TRAFFIC IMPACT

U.S. Route 54 narrowed to a single lane of traffic, each direction, for 0.6 miles.



TIMEFRAME EXTENDED

Construction is expected to wrap up and traffic return to normal the **week of Nov. 4.**

Originally planned to end in mid-October, the joint deterioration on both the west and eastbound bridges were more extensive than anticipated and required additional work and time.

The deterioration is likely caused by weather, water, and salt that collected near this area and caused the steel to corrode.

RETURNING TO NORMAL

Week of Oct. 28:

- Head-to-head traffic ends.
- U.S. Route 54 remains reduced to one lane in each direction from the Missouri River to Missouri Boulevard.
- All current ramp closures will remain in place.

Week of Nov. 4:

- Normal traffic patterns resume:
 - All lanes reopen.
 - All exits reopen.

Westbound U.S. Route 54 will remain in the same configuration it is now until the week of Nov. 4. Continue to use all lanes until the merge point.
