Southwest St. Louis County Major Construction 2025-2026



Interstate 55 bridge and pavement improvements - This project replaces or rehabilitates the driving surfaces on several bridges along I-55 between I-44 and River Des Peres. This year, crews will work between River Des Peres and Loughborough on both the northbound and southbound lanes. Drivers can expect shifted traffic lanes between Weber and Loughborough as crews remove and replace the driving surface on several bridges. Cyclists can expect a full closure of the Carondelet Connector south of Loughborough for a period in the year. Crews will pave portions of the interstate and associated interchanges as bridge work is completed. The project continues through late 2025.

Interstate 55 sign updates – This project reviews and replaces overhead signs along I-55 between the Poplar Street Bridge and the Ste. Genevieve County line. Work continues through late 2026.

Interstate 64 bridge rehabilitation – This project rehabilitates the westbound bridge over the Missouri River. Drivers can anticipate around the clock lane closures during the work. Rehabilitation starts in early 2025 and continues through the year.

Interstate 255 preventative maintenance – This project makes pavement repairs and resurfaces to the portion of southbound (eastbound) Interstate 255 between I-55 and the Mississippi River. Work should start in mid-2025 and be complete later in mid-2026.

Interstate 270 bridge replacement – This project continues work to replace the I-270 bridge over Conway just north of the I-64 interchange. The project also widens and replaces the driving surface on the I-270 bridge over Ladue Road. Work should be completed by late 2025.


Route 21 roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signals and guardrail, updates sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements and resurfaces the roadway between Route 30 and the Jefferson County line. Work starts in early 2025 and continues through late 2026.

Route 61/67 (Lindbergh) roadway improvements – This project continues to update signals and sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements and resurfaces the roadway between Swan Drive and Route D (Page Ave). Also includes a complete roadway closure in summer 2025 to remove and replace the bridge over Deer Creek south of Conway/German. Project should be complete in late 2025.

Route 61/67 (Lemay Ferry) roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signals and guardrail, updates sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements and resurfaces the roadway between Lindbergh and the Jefferson County line. Work starts in mid-2025 and continues through mid-2027.

Route 100 (Manchester) roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks, and sidewalks between Route 141 and I-270 to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. Includes replacing culverts at Grand Glaize and Glaize creeks, and bridge maintenance at I-270 and over Des Peres Road. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in mid-2025 and will be complete in mid-2027.

Route 100 roadway improvements – This project resurfaces the roadway between Route 00 and Route 109 in Wildwood. Includes a project by the city of Wildwood to add left turn lanes in the two-



be resurfaced and restriped. In areas, lanes will be removed and repurposed, and in other areas lane widths will be reduced to help moderate traffic speeds. Construction starts in mid-2025 and continues into 2027.

Route 231 (Telegraph) roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Franru and the Meramec River to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in mid- to late 2025 and will be complete in 2027.

Route 267 (Lemay Ferry) roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Lindbergh and River City Boulevard to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2025 and will be complete in late 2026.

Route 340 (Olive) roadway improvements – This project resurfaces the roadway between I-270 and Dielman, and updates sidewalks, signals and crosswalks as necessary to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. Work starts in early 2025 and continues into fall 2025.

Route 366 (Watson) roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Geyer and the St. Louis city limits to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. The bridge over Gravois Creek will be replaced. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2025 and will be complete in late 2026.

Route AB (Ladue) roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signals, crosswalks and sidewalks between I-270 and Route 141 to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2025 and continues into late 2025.





lane section at Hawks Rest, Windy Hollow, Hencken and Woodland Meadows and J-turns to enhance safety at Route T and Pond Road. Work starts in early 2025 and should be complete in late 2025.



Route 109 roadway improvements – This project resurfaces the roadway between Route CC and Route 100. It also resurfaces all of Route BA (which goes from Route 109 to Babler Park). It starts in early 2025 and continues through the year.



Route 109 at Route CC intersection improvements – This project converts the Route 109 intersection with Route CC to a modified two-lane roundabout. Work continues until late 2025.

Route 141 roadway improvements – This project makes several safety and traffic movement updates on the Route 141 and I-64 interchange. It also resurfaces the roadway between St. Luke's Hospital Road and I-64. This project starts in early 2025 and continues through late 2025.



Route 231 (Telegraph) roadway improvements – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between the city of St. Louis and Franru Lane to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will

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Interstate 64 sign updates – This project reviews and replaces overhead signs along I-64 between the Poplar Street Bridge and I-70 in St. Charles County. Work continues through late 2027.



Interstate 170 ramp maintenance – This project puts a thin protective layer on the various ramps between Interstate 64 and Interstate 170. Work should start in spring 2026 and be complete later in the year.



Route 30 (Gravois) roadway improvements – This project will update the section of Route 30 between Route 141 and the St. Louis city limits and then resurface the roadway. Should include signal and lighting updates as well as some updates to the sidewalks, if needed. Work should start in 2026 and be complete in 2027.



Route 340 (Olive) roadway improvements – This project resurfaces the roadway between I-170 and Ferguson (end of state maintenance), and updates sidewalks, signals and crosswalks as necessary to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. Work starts in early 2026 and continues through 2027.
