Sealed bids will be received by the Owner, the **City of Mountain View, Mountain View, MO**, at the offices of **Mountain View City Hall at 126 Oak Street, Mountain View, MO, 65548** until 2:00 p.m. local time, on **Thursday, March 27, 2025** and then publicly opened and read aloud, for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work necessary for completing the **Airfield Pavement Maintenance project**.

In general, the improvements on which bids are requested will require the following major construction items:

- Installation of temporary airport safety measures to allow for construction operations.
- Pavement marking removal.
- Cleaning of existing pavements and routing of cracks and joints where required.
- Joint and crack repairs (asphalt and concrete)
- Surface treatment (seal coat) application.
- Asphalt pavement patching.
- Concrete spall repair where required.
- Temporary and permanent pavement marking application.

Parties then interested in submitting an official bid must contact Benesch (913-213-5931 or 816-323-0074) and request an official bid booklet. The electronic documents do not contain the official bid booklet. Contractors must obtain an official bid booklet from Benesch to submit a bid.

A pre-bid meeting will NOT be held in conjunction with this project. All bidders are required to examine the site to become familiar with all site conditions.

Contractors shall coordinate with Eddie Owens, (417) 934-2601 for site visit opportunities. The Owner reserves the right, at the time of the site visit, to reject requests to inspect specific areas of the airfield, if it is not conducive to airport operations at the time.

Prequalification: Contractor's bidding need not be pre-qualified but shall be qualified to do the work. Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty (per 49 CFR Part 18.36(h)(1)) in the amount of not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check on a solvent bank or bid bond made payable to the **City of Mountain View of Mountain View, MO**.

All proposals submitted in accordance with the instructions presented herein will be subject to evaluation. Bids may be held by the **City of Mountain View of Mountain View, MO** for a period not to exceed **ninety (90) calendar days** from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

Award of contract will be based on the lowest aggregate sum proposal (for the award option that is in the Owner's best interest based on available Federal Funding) submitted from those bidders that are confirmed as being responsive and responsible. **Contractors bidding shall bid all items.** The right is reserved, by the Owner, to reject any and all bids and to waive any or all irregularities, technicalities, informality or any information in the bids received.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate performance and payment bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract.

Prospective Bidders are hereby advised that award of contract is contingent upon owner receiving Federal funding assistance under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP).

DBE Requirement: This project is subject to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation. The owner has established a contract participation goal of **0.00 percent** for small business concerns owned and controlled by certified socially and economically disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE). The Owner's award of this contract is conditioned upon Bidder or Offeror satisfying the good faith effort requirements of 49 CFR §26.53.

Civil Rights – Title VI Solicitation Notice:

The **City of Mountain View (Sponsor)**, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, 42 USC §§ 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders or offerors that it will affirmatively ensure that for any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and no businesses will be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin (including limited English proficiency), creed, sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity), age, or disability in consideration for an award.

In accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, and the Missouri Prevailing Wage Law, the Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor and the Missouri Division of Labor Standards, respectively. The highest rate between the two (Federal and State) for each job classification shall be considered the prevailing wage.
