PROJECT MANUAL

1	004200 Bid Proposal, 12.	Clarrification: The total anticipated dirt backfill quantity for the project is approximately 12,000CY. This is a surface to surface quantity and is based off drone site survey and available LiDAR data sources. This quantity is considered approximate. The bidder is responsible for calculating and verifying their own quantity. Dirt will be obtained from an adjacent borrow area owned by the Port.

3	Attachment A - Job Special Provisions	Change: Section A. Project Dates, 2.0 Basis of Payment to the following: Payment for the purchase of the materials and work performed on project is intended to be made by June 15, 2026 . Payments for construction shall be made based upon progress as determined by the Engineer, Owner, and Owner's operator. If additional time is required to complete the project, then request shall be submitted to the Owner.
