## Proposed Improvements -

This project aims to create a safer, more efficient, and more reliable flow of traffic on westbound U.S. Route 54 between the U.S. Route 63 interchange and the Missouri River bridge.

- Providing southbound U.S. Route 63 with a dedicated lane onto the Missouri River bridge, eliminating the need to immediately merge with westbound U.S. Route 54.
- Reconfiguring the ramp from Callaway County Route
   W (Airport Road) to westbound U.S. Route 54.
- Reconstructing the pavement on westbound U.S.
   Route 54 approaching the Missouri River bridge.

## Traffic Impacts —

- Southbound U.S. Route 63 and westbound U.S. Route 54 will remain open.
- Single lane closures on westbound U.S. Route 54 will be necessary.
- The exit ramp from westbound U.S. Route 54 to Airport Road is expected to close temporarily for an extended period.

## **Current Proposed Timeline**

- November 2025: Contractors submit competitive bids.
- December 2025: Missouri Highways and
   Transportation Commission may award contract for work
- February 2026: Earliest the contractor may begin work.
- End of 2026: Anticipated completion of project.
