Sealed bids for **Salem Road Extension - STBG 3301(536)** will be received at: **Lawson City Hall, 103 S Pennsylvania Ave, Lawson, MO 64062** until **10:00 o'clock A.M.** (Prevailing Local Time) on the **12th** day of **June**, and at that time will be publicly opened and read in the Community Room at Lawson City Hall. All bids shall be submitted in the form of hard copy.

The proposed work includes: Approximately 2300' of extension of Salem Road from Hazel Avenue to Route D. The project includes grading, storm sewer, asphalt pavement, curb & gutter, sidewalks & ramps, and streetlighting.

All Bids must be in accordance with the Plans and other Bidding Documents on file at the Drexel Technologies public plan room located on-line at: www.drexeltech.com. Bidders must fill out the on-line registration to request Bidding Documents, Plan Holder's List, AND TO RECEIVE ADDENDA. All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Lawson, Missouri hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

This project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Lawson, Missouri reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 5%.
