

DALLAS COUNTY US 65 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS Buffalo, MO



PROJECT FACTS

- Build Roundabout at Dallas County U.S. Route 65 and Route 73 in Buffalo
 - Approximately 8,800 vehicles per day use the intersection
 - Truck Aprons provide for Oversize Overweight Vehicles
 - Roundabout increased 20 feet in diameter to accommodate semi-truck movements



- Build Roundabout at Dallas County U.S. Route 65 and Truman Road in Buffalo
 - Pedestrian Facilities are part of the intersection
 - Approximately 11,300 vehicles per day use the intersection
 - Interior Islands to accommodate Oversize Overweight Vehicles

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- U.S. Route 65 will NOT be closed
- Drivers can expect occasional lane closures, lane shifts and traffic delays
- Electronic message boards and new releases will notify the public of traffic impacts
- Drivers urged to use alternate routes during construction to avoid the work zone



- Work in Benton County
 - Passing Lanes
 - Roundabout at MO 7
- Work in Hickory County
 - Passing Lanes
- Work in Dallas County
 - Passing lane between Route 64 and Route D in Urbana



- Construction to begin in Winter 2027
- U.S. Route 65 & Route 73 Estimated Total Cost: \$5.2 million
- U.S. Route 65 & Truman Estimated Total Cost: \$4.7 million
