## **Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for 25-063 St Charles County Countywide ATSPM Project CMAQ-7302 (705) will be received at: 201 North Second Street Room 116 until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 2025, at the office of the St. Charles County Finance Department and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of One [1] written signed original, one [1] signed copy and one [1] digitized copy of the bid must be received in a sealed envelope plainly marked with the name, date, and time of the bid opening in the lower left corner of the envelope.

The proposed work includes traffic signal improvements, including video and advanced detection upgrades, controller replacements, and high-resolution data logging configurations for Automated Traffic Signal Performance Measures.

Up to four (4) full sets of drawings and two (2) full sets of specifications will be provided to the successful CONTRACTOR by St. Charles County at no cost to the CONTRACTOR. Additional sets may be purchased by the CONTRACTOR at the printing cost plus ten percent (10%) for handling.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

St. Charles County hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

St. Charles County reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
